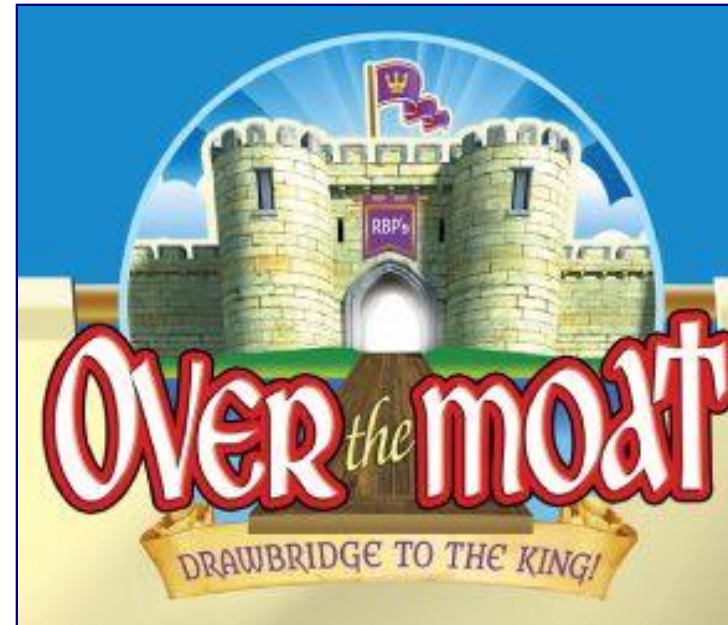

To the Church and all admirers of the Sanctuary Choir:

This Sunday, May 28th, we say farewell (for now) to the choir that has provided this congregation with anthems and special music galore over the past year. They will be taking a much deserved break. Don’t worry though, because they will be back before you know it! Their final piece before breaking for the summer is an arrangement of the spiritual song “Joshua Fit the Battle of Jericho,” a piece which loosely fits into the theme of this Memorial Day weekend, a holiday which commemorates this nation’s armed service members and their achievements and deeds on behalf of the American people.

“Joshua Fit the Battle” is a high energy choral piece that recounts the biblical tale of Joshua and his capture of the city Jericho in the Old Testament. Modern interpretation of this text has drawn parallels between the captivity of the Israelites and the slaves in American history. Both groups had used this story as a beacon of hope that God will deliver His people in the face of overwhelming odds and obstacles. During this Memorial Day weekend, that sentiment is echoed in our remembering and honoring of the armed service men and women who have gone before us, and our hope is that He will use their service and sacrifice as a conduit for God-sized deliverance and protection in the future.

After this Sunday, be looking forward to the special Summer music provided by instrumentalists and soloists while the choir is resting, and await the choir’s return in August!
